In just three months of planning The Source LGBT+ Center opened its doors on May 6th 2016 at 208 W Main St. This year we doubled our capacity to serve our community while raising enough money through partnerships to hire our Executive Director. We hosted our first PRIDE Visalia, and outreached to over 1 million through social and traditional media. What an awesome year.

## THE YEAR IN REVIEW!

In 2016 we began this journey. Together we have raised awareness, acceptance, sensitivity, and community spirits, all while adhering to a mission and a vision we believe in. In 2017 we built upon that success.

If you check our Facebook page you will find over 3,500 likes (an increase of 2,000 from last year), 25 special events, 12+ sensitivity trainings, 10+ HIV peer support meetings, Transgender Resources Program, an annual PRIDE ride, the first PRIDE Visalia attended by over 2,000 community members,



national and international media attention with a feature on NPR and The Advocate, our first viral social media post, the only Crystal Meth Anonymous meeting in Tulare County, 10 F1RST Friday art exhibits, our first annual Halloween Ball, a book club, TDOR, our inaugural LGBT Leadership Academy, and our award winning "A World That Works for Everyone" Christmas Tree auction entry. We could name a few more, but you get the picture: 2017 was a great year.

Our projected budget for the first year was \$20,000 and our community helped us raise over \$35,000. In our second year we have more than tripled that with an operating budget exceeding \$135,000. We look forward to 2018 where we hope to expand our reach into Hanford, Tulare, and Porterville with our partners: United Way of Tulare County, San Joaquin Valley Health Fund, The California Endowment, Tulare Health and Human Services, and well as Suicide Prevention Task Force.

I want to personally thank our volunteers, our donors, and the tireless commitment and energy of our board. The work and effort put forth for our LGBT+ community will have long standing effects for decades to come. You have been part of something historical. 2017 was a monumental year for LGBT+ people in rural California and The Source LGBT+ Center in Visalia was the epicenter. I applaud you. I appreciate you. I am grateful for you.







The Source LGBT+ Center compiled data of our visitors over 2017. Here's a look at who we serve, why they came in, and how they heard about us.




## SEX ASSIGNED AT BIRTH

# GENDER IDENTITY






SAME as sex assigned at birth

## SEXUALITY


